Dunes Preserve & Dog Park

"Don't worry, my dog's friendly... well, except for that one time." Even the friendliest pups can have moments. That's why our open spaces need a few ground rules.

- Dogs must wear ID collars and be fully vaccinated
- Leash dogs entering/leaving designated parking areas
- Your dog's business is your business—please pick it up
- No hole digging (dogs or owners) and stay out of lakes (dogs or owners)
- An owner may bring a max of three dogs
- Aggressive animals and behavioral incidents must be reported to the POA

In general, keep your dog in sight, on leash when needed, and drama-free.

Come In!

The ABDI gate access app can be downloaded from the app store on your portable device.

- The community code is "POLO"
- Your username is the phone number attached to your account including area code. Your password is your assigned five-digit PIN number.
- Don't give the 5-digit pin number to your friends (no matter how much you like them)



Cart Smart

- Register with the POA for your decal.
 cost \$75—contact the office to get rolling!
- Licensed drivers only: No license, no driving. Minors are off-limits!
- Stick to the cart paths
- Yield to pedestrians & cyclists
- Stop at Intersections: No sign? Stop anyway!
- Lights On After Dark: Headlights and tail for evening rides.

Park Smart

We're all urged to have a working alarm system, use visible lighting on timers, and lock doors, windows, and vehicles. Don't leave valuables in sight—every stolen vehicle had keys left inside (Hello!)

- No parking on grass and no on-street parking between midnight and 6am
